The beer, made using a blend of cocoa butter, cocoa powder and pure cocoa liquor, was developed by the British company that acquired the Dutch company 10 years ago. "It is a first for the UK and the UK market. Everyone is used to either strong lager or strong ale as a premium drink," said Neil Cartwright, spokesman for Diageo. "This is the first time a high cocoa drink has been done." The chocolatey liquid is for people who drink to cope. Those who have the time, or a coffee maker, can make a cuppa the old-fashioned way. "It was developed to be a beery coffee, or to sip with chocolate," said Cartwright. "It's the drink for people who can't cope with the way they feel on a day to day basis." Diageo made the first sample of chocolate beer in 1977 in Tintagel, Cornwall, inspired by the legend of King Arthur and his knights. The beer, which has been developed to keep those who drink it on their toes, as well as to help those who suffer from jet lag and fly-hunger, is available in bars in London's Canary Wharf, New York's Rockefeller Centre and in the Portuguese city of Porto. The beer's recipe is a secret, but from about 35 percent alcohol it drops to eight per cent. "You can have the full-strength, but I wouldn't recommend it," said Cartwright. "It's more of a distraction as it's a bit of a heady sensation." People who drink the strong beer drink a lot because they want to have an effect on themselves, said the spokesman. "It's not as inebriating as some beers that are done for that purpose," he said.
